At the tour, participants will hear from residents and staff whose lives have been changed by the nonprofit's housing, services and programs for modest-income families.

In Sacramento, people need to earn \$19.98 per hour to afford a two-bedroom apartment, yet the average hourly wage for a renter is \$14.20 per hour.
