For the fifth year, the Sacramento Mutual Housing Association is offering free income tax preparation to help low-income people get the tax credits they qualify for, such as the Earned Income Tax Credit.

To qualify for free tax preparation, a person usually cannot earn more than \$40,000 a year.

During February, tax preparers will be working at Victory Townhomes, 1075 Dixieanne Ave., North Sacramento, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturdays and by appointment on Thursdays.

They also will be available on Thursdays and Saturdays from March until April 15, by appointment.
