

Free tax preparation available at several sites

Free tax preparation services will be available to low-income families and individuals during several scheduled events in the Sacramento area in January and February.

The “Super Site Tax Events” are sponsored by the Sacramento Coalition for Working Families, Sacramento Mutual Housing Association, Internal Revenue Service and Franchise Tax Board.

The groups note that people often pay \$75 for preparation of a simple EZ return, cutting into much-needed refund money. The Super Site Tax Events will provide free tax preparation to households earning less than \$49,000 per year.
