

Twin Pines apartment complex receives funding for upgrades

Sacramento Yolo Mutual Housing Association recently received more than \$5 million in grants and loans to make improvements and increase energy efficiency at four local multi-family housing developments, including Twin Pines in Davis.

Construction is expected to start next month at Twin Pines, 3333 F St., and at Glen Ellen Estates, Foothill Plaza and Mutual Housing at Norwood in Sacramento.

Twin Pines is spending \$255,000 for new awnings, iron fencing and paint as well as improvements to the community center and the community garden at the 36-unit property. A total of \$155,000 comes from NeighborWorks America and \$100,000 from city of Davis housing trust funds.

With 15 communities in the region, Mutual Housing develops and operates affordable rental housing units for 2,600 residents, half of whom are children.

Founded in 1988, the nonprofit also provides training and mentoring as well as educational programs, community-building activities and services for residents and neighbors. For more information, visit <http://www.mutualhousing.com>
