

NeighborWorks America awards Sacramento Mutual Housing Assn. \$460,500 grant

Sacramento Mutual Housing Association recently was awarded \$460,500 in flexible first-round grant funds from NeighborWorks® America (NWA). This funding will pay for operating costs in SMHA's efforts to revitalize and sustain the community as well as promote and preserve housing for the residents of Sacramento and Yolo Counties.

With the funding, SMHA also will increase financial education and computer training sessions for residents, assist youth leaders in decreasing school violence in targeted neighborhoods, rehabilitate existing properties with energy efficiencies, complete feasibility analysis for solar installation at the four Davis properties and develop a financial plan for the 15-year buy-out of their Low-Income Housing Tax Credit communities.
