The Sacramento|Yolo Mutual Housing Association will host groundbreaking ceremonies next week for its New Harmony apartment community in Davis.

Ceremonies are set for 10 a.m. Oct. 21 at 3023 Albany Ave., in the Owendale Mutual Housing Community Room adjacent to New Harmony site.

The 69-apartment community will have one-, two- and three-bedroom units for families with limited incomes. Each unit will have a private patio, energy-efficient appliances, environmentally friendly building materials and high-quality indoor air filters.

The association also said the apartments will be wheelchair-accessible, have free Internet access and minimal utility bills.

“At New Harmony, Davis families will soon have the option of moving to a green, healthy home,” said Rachel Iskow, association executive director.

The vacant parcel was one of the few multifamily-zoned lots left in Davis.
