

Mutual Housing gets \$450K green grant

Sacramento-Yolo Mutual Housing Association has been awarded a \$450,000 federal grant to add green elements to the rehabilitation of a local housing community, Mutual Housing at Norwood.

Mutual Housing is one of 115 organizations to receive a grant under a \$34.9 million program to provide funding for the rehabilitation of affordable housing.

The Norwood rehabilitation will include replacement of heating and cooling systems with Energy Star condensers, efficient lighting and appliances.

The NeighborWorks America grant also will go toward replacement of water heaters with high-efficiency model heaters.

The total cost of the rehabilitation at Norwood is \$2.7 million. Funding also came from Community Housing Capital and the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency.
