Free tax help in Russian, Ukrainian and Hmong languages is available for low-income taxpayers and seniors, starting Wednesday.

The free tax preparation services, also available in English, are aimed at households earning less than \$49,000 a year. They're sponsored by the Sacramento/Yolo Mutual Housing Association at various area locations.

The weekly schedule runs from February through April 17, the state and federal tax filing deadline. Appointments are required.
