Lottery deadline for New Harmony extended



Applications for the housing lottery waiting list at New Harmony in Davis have been extended to July 6. Applications must be postmarked by that date to be entered into the lottery.

Housing lottery applications may be picked up at any Mutual Housing community in Davis: Owendale, 3023 Albany Ave.; Tremont Green, 5663 Marden Drive; Twin Pines, 3333 F St.; or Moore Village, 2444 Moore Blvd.

The latest Sacramento/Yolo Mutual Housing Association community has 69 one-, two- and three- bedroom apartments. New Harmony also will have free Internet access, savings on utilities due to solar power, a community garden, basketball court and children's play area. It also has washer and dryer hook-ups, large patios, a community club house and laundry facilities.

New Harmony is located on Cowell Road near Mace Boulevard, close to Yolo and Unitrans lines.

Rents for apartments vary, depending on household income and family size. Tables for each are part of the application. There are income restrictions.

Occupancy at the latest Sacramento/Yolo Mutual Housing Association community is expected to start in January.

A lottery drawing for the waiting list will begin at 1 p.m. Friday, July 20, in the Community Chambers at Davis City Hall, 23 Russell Blvd. All applicants will be notified of their position on the waiting list by Aug. 3.

Anyone who misses the lottery deadline still may apply for the waiting list. These applications will be taken on a
