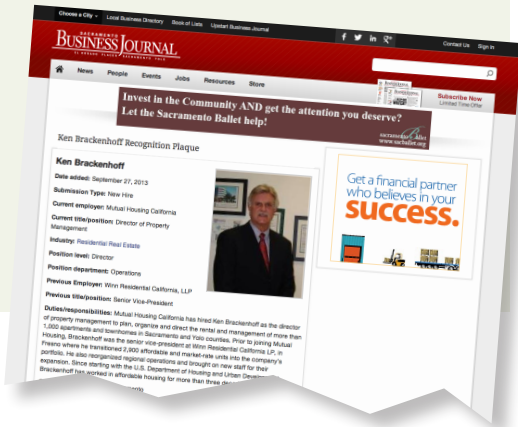
Since starting with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Brackenhoff has worked in affordable housing for more than three decades.
