



Affordable housing workshops hosted in Davis

Beginning on Monday, 7 p.m. the city of Davis Social Services Commission will hold the first in a series of four community workshops to discuss the city's affordable housing program and recommend options for the future.

The public is encouraged to attend these workshops to join the discussion with the Commission and local community panelists.

Monday's workshop will be held at the New Harmony Community Room, at 3030 Cowell Boulevard in South Davis, and will focus on a historical look at the affordable housing program.

Panelists will include Lisa Baker of Yolo County Housing, Rachel Iskow of Mutual Housing California, Ben Pearl of Solar Community Housing Association, and Luke Watkins of Neighborhood Partners, LLC.

Future workshops will be held on June 9, June 23, and July 21 to discuss Housing Production and Constraints, Inventory and Planning of Affordable Housing Resources, and Conclusions and Recommendations.
